### Drawing Club & Writing

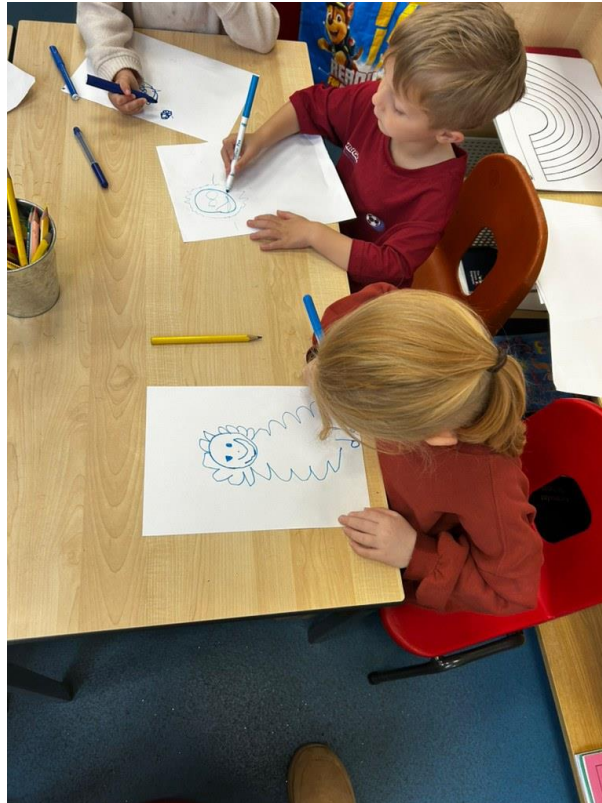
